THE 4th ANNUAL ANAHEIM COMMUNITY PRIDE POSTER CONTEST IS COMING TO THE CITY OF ANAHEIM PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS!

ANAHEIM, CA – April 25, 2017 - Anaheim Beautiful is proud to announce that beginning today elementary students throughout the Anaheim school districts will have the opportunity to participate in the first Anaheim Community Pride Poster Contest, formerly known as Green Ribbon Week. Anaheim Beautiful presents the contest in partnership with the City of Anaheim Department of Public Works, Code Enforcement Division and Republic Services.

Community Pride is a contest offered to all public schools in Anaheim for students, 1st through 6th grade. Students are invited to create a poster on one of the following Community Pride themes: **Recycling, Graffiti-Free, Litter-Free**. The mission is to promote and bring awareness to anti-littering, anti-graffiti and recycling, as well as educate students on the importance of keeping Anaheim and the Earth Beautiful. The winning artwork will be displayed on the Anaheim Beautiful website and The City of Anaheim's Public Works recycling page.

Contest Overview - There are three levels to the Anaheim Community Pride Poster Contest: School, District and City level. All participating schools will receive free posters for students to submit their entries and Community Pride wristbands. Certificates will be given to the first, second and third place winners at the school level (per grade level). District winners will receive a plaque and a Community Pride hat. City level winners will receive (4) passes to Disneyland! Please plan on joining us in person or on the local television channel for the presentation of the Community Pride Poster Contest City winners with the City of Anaheim's Mayor and City Council.
